The Intra-European Organisation of Tax Administrations (IOTA) and the OECD Forum on Tax Administration (FTA) are organising a Partnership Event "Tax Debt Management Maturity Model", which will be broadcast live via the Microsoft Teams platform on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of November 2024 from 13:00 (CET).

The main objective of this joint event is to provide officials with theoretical and practical knowledge on how to apply the Tax Debt Management Maturity Model in tax administration. Participants will hear about the experiences of other tax administrations in conducting self-assessment, organisation of the self-assessment process, operational tools used, conclusions drawn, targets/goals after the assessment, strategies and action plans to increase the maturity level, challenges and lessons learned, etc.

This Digital Workshop will focus on:

- The examples of best practices for using the Tax Debt Management Maturity Model across IOTA and OECD FTA member tax administrations, including organisation and management of the self-assessment process;
- Benefits and strong points of the use of the Model;
- Guidance for other tax administrations on the application of the Model to build the strategies;
- Sharing lessons learned.

This event will help the participating jurisdictions use the Model better to improve their strategy of tax debt management.
