Overview of Capacity-Building Support Delivered on the Two-Pillar Solution in 2024

43 multilateral events across Africa, Asia-Pacific, Europe, Latin America, the Caribbean and the Middle East reaching over 6500 participants

- **19** regional events (**7** co-hosted)
- 4 Pillars Knowledge Sharing Network sessions on Amount B and GloBE
- 15 training events on the Pillars including in-person and virtual
- 5 multilateral interactive workshops on the GMT and economic impact assessment in small country groups

57 developing countries received bilateral support across all aspects of the Pillars

- •9 Pilot Programmes on the GMT and Tax Incentives
- •16 IF and non-IF members received support on tax incentives
- •On-site missions, training sessions, workshops in Africa, Asia-Pacific, Europe and LAC

Economic Impact Assessment (EIA)

- •71 developing countries received revised jurisdiction-specific revenue estimates of the GMT and methodological notes to conduct their own internal EIA
- •EIA methodology of Pillar Two was published in both English and French

E-learning

- Updated E-learning module on the GloBE Rules in French and Spanish
- Recorded webinars on the STTR in Arabic, English, French and Spanish as well as on Amount B in English

Continues engagement with development partners

Increase the number of smaller multilateral capacity-building activities across all aspects of the Two-Pillar Solution

Continues to integrate support for the implementation of the Two-Pillar Solution into established bilateral programmes as well as new ones
