The Intra-European Organisation of Tax Administrations (IOTA) is organising the meeting of the IOTA Forum on Implementation of Measures to counter Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (BEPS), which will be held in Budapest, Hungary, on 21–22 May 2025.

Delegates attending this Forum will achieve a greater understanding and awareness of:

- ongoing work of OECD and IOTA members regarding the BEPS implementation process;
- current developments of the Two Pillar Solution Pillar Two implementation and the challenges for tax administrations;
