GROUP DISCUSSION SESSION 1 – i) General questions about CRS, ii) Operational implementation of amended CRS (CRS 2.0) and CARF

Wednesday, 26 November 2025, 12:00– 13:00 (CET)

AIM

This session will discuss on the one hand, the tax administration's view on the financial impact of CRS implementation, as well as the measurement or estimation, of the potential behavioural change of taxpayers.

On the other hand, there will be a debate regarding the application of CRS 2.0 and CARF. Participants are invited to share their views on the current status that their tax administration lies regarding their implementation, as well as the improvements that they think these initiatives will bring, both on the compliance of the Financial Institutions, but also on the compliance of taxpayers.

FORMAT

The session is intended as a facilitated group discussion. The delegates will be split into three discussion groups. The composition of groups can be found in the Document uploaded to the IOTA event page. Each group will have a designated virtual breakout room.

The chairperson will be responsible for moderating the discussion. Chairpersons are not expected to be experts who can answer every question. The chairpersons should guide the conversation among the group members and contribute their questions and views too. Each delegate should be encouraged to contribute to the discussion.

The chairperson will be required to **take notes** of the group's discussions and **report** on the discussion summary and conclusions at the plenary session in the end of the event. The chairperson can delegate this task to a volunteer in the group.

REQUIRED INPUT AND TIMING

Total time: 60 minutes.

- Chairperson explains the aim of the group session (5 minutes)

- Group discussion (50 minutes):

1. *What methods does your administration use—or plan to use—to quantify the financial impact of CRS data, such as additional tax revenue from reassessments, recovered taxes, or voluntary disclosures triggered by CRS-related activities?*
2. *Beyond direct revenue gains, how do you measure or estimate the deterrent effect of CRS implementation—i.e. the behavioural change among taxpayers who now comply voluntarily because they know their foreign accounts are being reported?*



3. *Regarding the implementation of the amended CRS (CRS 2.0), what is the current status of your tax administration at domestic level (legislative framework, AEOI solution, etc.)?*
4. *As the commencement date for CARF is approaching, do you feel you are on the right track for collecting user and transaction data?*
5. *What are the challenges that you have faced so far regarding CARF preparatory work, and what are the expected benefits that you aim to have from the exploitation of that data?*
