Invitation to IOTA Webinar “Use of VITARA for L&D/HR Professionals”

The Intra-European Organisation of Tax Administrations (IOTA) is organising a **webinar “Use of VITARA for L&D/HR Professionals”**, which will be broadcast live via the Microsoft Teams platform on **4 March 2026 starting at 14:00 (CET) and finishing at 15:30 (CET)**.

The Webinar is aimed at updating IOTA member tax administrations about the learning opportunities offered by VITARA - Virtual Training to Advance Revenue Administration, e-learning modules designed for tax officials on the basis of globally recognised good practices from the leading international organisations in tax administration. The main objective of this digital event is to assist HR and L&D officials in tax administrations in integrating the VITARA online curriculum into their internal learning programs.

The Webinar will start with the presentation by the IMF on the VITARA developments. Participating tax administrations will also share their VITARA learning experience, and HR and L&D professionals will discuss the ways of how to integrate VITARA into their administrations' learning curricula.

More specifically, the Webinar will:

- Explore the current scope of VITARA e-learning modules and supporting reference materials (microlearning videos, Reference Guides).
- Learn more about the enrolment process and opportunities for tax administration officials.
- Bring examples of VITARA learning experience in tax administrations and the practical steps that HR and L&D professionals can take to facilitate the integration of VITARA in their internal training programs.

The target audience of this event includes L&D and HR managers and senior experts in IOTA member tax administrations, experts responsible for the organisation of internal

training. IOTA will also invite representatives of other VITARA partner organisations, the Inter-American Centre of Tax Administrations (CIAT), the International Monetary Fund (IMF), and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and their members to participate in this digital event.

There is no limit to the number of participants who can attend the IOTA webinar. However, participants are required to register for this event **by 2 March 2026** using [the IOTA e-registration form](#) available on the IOTA web portal. The day before the start of the event, participants will receive an email from the IOTA Secretariat with a link to access the event using MS Teams.
