### *Invitation to the IOTA Digital Workshop “Digital Identity and eGovernment in the Tax Domain”*

Dear Colleagues,

The Intra-European Organisation of Tax Administrations (IOTA) is organising the **digital workshop** on “*Digital Identity and eGovernment in the Tax Domain*”, which will be **broadcast live via Microsoft Teams** on **22–23 April 2026**.

The workshop will benefit from presentations delivered by representatives of international organisations, member tax administrations and observers **focusing on:**

- Digital identity frameworks and key concepts applicable to taxation to guide digital identity strategies for tax administration
- Peer exchange related to the practical implementation of digital identity, including systems architecture, interoperability, risk mitigation practices, and cross-border solutions
- Key governance features – security, privacy, data protection, risk management, and accountability.

**Delegates** attending this event will be officials from IOTA member tax administrations, **who** are specialised or have a strong interest in **digital identity management, authentication, taxpayer registration, electronic services, regulatory and technical expertise governing taxpayer identification** (e.g. data protection, security).

The workshop will be conducted through a mix of **presentations, Q&A sessions, and group discussions**.





The group discussion sessions will provide participants with the opportunity to share their approaches to exploring risks and design challenges when implementing digital identity solutions for cross-border SME taxpayers using digital tax services, particularly under different identity architecture models. Participants will analyse a fictional case and identify operational, legal, security, and user-experience risks that tax administrations should consider. It is important that participants of the group discussion session take time to prepare for the debate and read the documents (the case study and the subsequent questions).

There is no limit to the number of participants from each tax administration. However, registration is mandatory and must be completed by **16 April 2026** using the [IOTA e-registration form](#) available on the IOTA web portal. Delegates who wish to actively participate in the group discussion session by sharing experiences, views, or insights must indicate this in the registration form.
