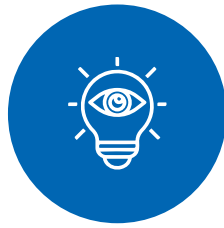

Low Risk



Internal Use

- ▶ Help topic summarization
- ▶ Tool calls that retrieve



Human in Loop

- ▶ Humans reviewing AI output and making decision

High Risk



External Use

- ▶ Chatbots
- ▶ Tool calls that change



Full Automation

- ▶ AI output directly used in fully automated process

Transaction-level analytics indicate elevated variance between point-of-sale records, exemption usage, and reported taxable sales across multiple store locations, supporting a full-scope audit recommendation.

Potential Audit Issues

- Inconsistent application of local sales-tax rates across municipal and special district jurisdictions.
- Exemption certificates for wholesale and government outfitting accounts appear outdated or incomplete.
- Analytics indicate potential under-reported taxable sales in the range of 4%–7%.
- Multiple locations show higher-than-average voids, returns, and tax-override activity.

Routing customer correspondence based on content

Directing customers to specific FAQs based on correspondence content prior to submission

Drafting audit working paper reports and summaries

Classifying and directing return attachments based on content and intent
