exchange of information on foreign assets in enforcement procedures”**

Dear Colleagues,

The Intra-European Organisation of Tax Administrations (IOTA) is pleased to invite your administration to the workshop **“Use of data received through (spontaneous or automatic) exchange of information on foreign assets in enforcement procedures”**, which will take place in Budapest on 4-5 November 2026.

The workshop will bring together experts from IOTA member tax administrations to explore how tax administrations use data received through spontaneous or automatic exchange of information to support enforcement actions, with a particular focus on foreign assets, and to identify practical approaches, challenges, and good practices in integrating such data into tax debt recovery processes.

The IOTA event's programme will explore how exchanged information on foreign assets is currently used and processed by participating member tax administrations in tax debt enforcement procedures. Particular attention will be given to identifying key challenges in accessing, processing, and applying exchanged data for debt recovery purposes. Participants will also examine the limitations of existing enforcement tools and legislation when dealing with assets located abroad.
